14. WHAT IS A DANCE CONVENTION?

This Fall Encore will get the chance to attend

The Royal Dance Competition's Fall Dance Convention.

Saturday, November 2nd Long Island, NY



A dance convention is a one day event in which dancers can attend dance workshops of various styles, taught by master teachers from across the country. The diverse group of master teachers provide students with the opportunity to learn and grow in a nurturing, high energy environment.

Not only will your dancers benefit from learning from other teachers, but they will also learn WITH other students from all over!

15. WHAT ARE MY ADDITIONAL FEES?

Although tuition is all inclusive and we work to make it a process that is as easy as possible for all of our families, there are additional fees when joining our competitive team. Please see below:

- Summer Dance Intensives--Encore is offering THREE dance intensives this summer for in replace of our regularly scheduled Summer classes.
- Summer GROUP DANCE Rehearsals--Competitive dance team members get a head start on 24-25 season with pre-season Summer Group Dance Rehearsals to learn your routines. A survey will be sent to schedule these rehearsals around your August conflicts, with a separate fee to cover these additional sessions (\$150 for Echo Mini Dancers, \$300 for Elite & Echo & \$250 for Epic Dancers). This early bird prep will boost your choreography knowledge, teamwork, and confidence before the regular season kicks off!
- **Private Lesson Fees**--Dancers who compete in a solo, duo and/or trio will have a weekly 30 minute private lesson. These classes can be paid for by class pack or individually. Class packs will be automatically renewed after the end of the previous pack, unless communicated otherwise. These dancers will get scheduled lessons prior to Sept. as well which are not included in the GROUP summer session fee.
- Competition Fees--Dance competitions charge an entry fee per routine. This fee goes directly to the competition organizer and covers the cost of running the event. The total amount you pay depends on how many dances you enter. The total cost depends on entries, with group dances ranging from \$50-\$65, duos/trios \$65-\$90, and solos \$100-\$150. Remember, these are estimates and may vary by competition.
- **Convention Fee**--The dance convention fee, ranging from \$135 to \$185, goes directly to the convention organizer, covers your dancer's entire day of workshops, classes from renowned instructors, performance opportunities, and helps run the event with venue rentals and staff. It's an investment in their dance development and a fun way to experience the dance world!

16. WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE COMPETITION EXPERIENCE?

- Costume and Music Selection -- Costume design and musical selection decisions are made solely by Encore Center for Performing Arts Staff. Costumes will be confirmed with the dancer and dancer's family before ordering. Music will also be discussed with the dancer and family before finalizing a song. Options may be given; however, the final decision is made by Encore, as all are a representation of the studio itself.
- **Placement**--By making a request, this does not mean your dancer will automatically be given one of these additional dances. By requesting a duet or trio, you are agreeing to accept the partner and routine selected for you. No changes will made after announcements are made. Based on your dancer's audition, teacher availability and style of assigned routine, your dancer will be assigned a choreographer and private lesson teacher.
- Solos, Duos & Trios: (Elite & Echo ONLY)-If granted a solo, duet, or trio, you would be required to have a 30 min private lesson for each solo, duet, or trio routine you are part of.
- AWARD CEREMONIES--Award ceremonies are usually held a few times each day of competitions, and are the MOST FUN time of the weekend! Team Members are required to wear studio branded attire on stage for ALL award ceremonies that they attend. Team Members are required to attend all award ceremonies for the dances that they are a part of, but are also allowed, and often enjoy, to go on stage for other award ceremonies to support their teammates. -
 - Awards are the time to:
 - Hoot and holler (parents AND dancers)
 - Take pictures
 - Sit back and relax!

16. WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE COMPETITION EXPERIENCE?

The most important thing to remember about awards is that ALL scores are the opinions of 3 or 4 judges.

"A dance competition is the way a certain set of judges view a certain set of dancers on a certain day. If we had done this competition yesterday, or if one of the judges had been someone else, chances are the results would in some way be different. It is good that we compete as dancers, because we compete every day in life. Competitions help to show us where we have been, where we are now, and where we have to aim to go in the future. But it is important to remember that the true worth of anyone, as a dancer or person, will never be measured by a trophy or cash prize.

17. CLASS ATTIRE-WHAT TO WEAR?

Elite & Echo Team Rehearsals:

All Black Leotard, skin colored tights and black spandex shorts. Hair sprayed back in a high ponytail.

Mini Echo Class/Rehearsal

All solid colored leotard with black shorts. Hair sprayed back in a high ponytail.

Epic Team Rehearsals:

All Black T-shirt and joggers or leggings with White Nike AF1 Sneakers. Hair sprayed back in a high ponytail or for boys, slicked back.

Electric & Elevate Apprentice:

Black Leotard with blue skirt (skirt provided) Hair pulled away from face.

Ballet: Solid Colored Leotard and skirt. (NO SHORTS/ additional layers)

Jazz: Solid Colored Leotard and shorts.

Lyrical: Solid Colored Leotard and shorts.

No additional layers are permitted in classes, as dancers will get warm right away and it is important for us to see lines.

18. STUDIO POLICIES

PAYMENT DETAILS:

Tuition is broken down to 10 payments, due the first of every month from September-June. Payment will be processed with the credit card we have on file.

It is **required** to have a Credit Card on File for all payment plans.

Seasonal tuition is prorated based on remaining contract length for families who join after the season begins.

Tickets to the annual recital will be available for purchase. Tickets will cost approximately \$25 each.

Tickets for Musical Performances will be available for purchase. Tickets will cost approximately \$25 each.

Tuition is based on the entire season and is billed the first of every month.

If you need to change any payment information you can do that through your parent portal or in the office before the 25th of each month.

If your student wishes to drop from our program, we required 30 Days in advanced notice. If you notify us about your drop less than 30 days before the next month charge, you will still be charged for the next month.

MUSICAL THEATRE POLICY: Encore believes that all students will learn necessary skills while being apart of a theatrical production and no part is any less significant than another. We expect all of our families to support this philosophy. We highly discourage musical theatre students from dropping the program due to unhappiness with their role. Students are expected to commit to the show once they register and audition, therefore if your child drops the program after casting, you will still be charged for the remainder of the semester. This policy does not apply to drops due to emergencies and illnesses.

Musical Theatre Tuition will be charged per session and due on the start of the season. Musical Theatre tuition is no longer eligible for monthly tuition.

Upon registration, there will be a \$50 deposit charged for each class to hold your students spot. (\$50 deposit is per student and is the same regardless of how many classes you register for)

If tuition payment is not received by the 5th of the month, it is considered late, and a late fee of \$25 will be added to your account. If your payment is not received by the 10th of each month, a daily late fee of \$5/day will be added until the payment is received.

MAKE UP CLASSES:

Missed classes may only be made up by prior appointment. If you know you are going to be absent from class, contact us in advance to arrange for a makeup class. No refund will be given for missed classes. Please refer to our studio calendar for vacation & holiday closings. Classes missed due to inclement weather may be made up in a class currently on the schedule or a separate make up class scheduled by ECPA. Cancellations by our staff will have a separate makeup class scheduled. We reserve the right to cancel a class or substitute a teacher as needed.

DISCOUNTS:

10% Sibling discount will be applied to the second, third & fourth sibling.\$25 referral credit for new students who enroll and list you as their referral family.10% discount for those who pay their tuition in FULL prior to the start of the season.

TRANSITION TO VIRTUAL CLASSES DUE TO GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS:

If Encore Center must transition to temporary virtual classes to Government restrictions preventing us from meeting in person, tuition fees still apply to full price and will not be refunded if you choose not to attend virtual class.

NCLEMENT WEATHER:

In case of inclement weather we operate on Byram Hills Central School District policy. If Byram Hills Central School District Schools are closed due to inclement weather, the studio will be closed also, unless we inform you otherwise. Classes will either be held via zoom or a makeup class will be scheduled for your children. We do not refund or pro-rate tuition due to inclement weather closings.

DRESS CODE:

Students are required to adhere to the class attire outlined for their class. The dress code is required for every class they attend. All students should have their hair up and out of their face. Hair should be secured and should not need to be restyled during class.

PHOTO & VIDEO:

By registering with Encore Center for Performing Arts, you agree that your child may be videoed or photographed during studio activities, included but not limited to performances, classes, rehearsals and content may appear on the studio website, social media page and other studio advertisements.

19. Advanced Programs Policies

- Dancers in Epic, Elite & Echo are required and expected to commit to the entire year of dance classes. If a dancer decides to drop from the competition team, tuition will still be charged for the remainder of the year, unless in the case of an emergency.
- Dancers on any of our Competitive Dance Teams, (Elite, Echo & Epic) are only permitted 4 team rehearsal absences throughout the year. We understand emergencies and illnesses arise so please always communicate with us.
- Punctuality is crucial. Team members must arrive on time and be fully prepared to participate at the designated start time.
- Unexcused absences include, but are not limited to: skipping practices, rehearsals, or performances without a valid reason, or failing to provide timely notification. Excessive unexcused absences may result in disciplinary action.


